We are home to many Bay Area projects with a shared political vision of more equitable commoning of resources and meeting human needs over private interests or corporate profit:

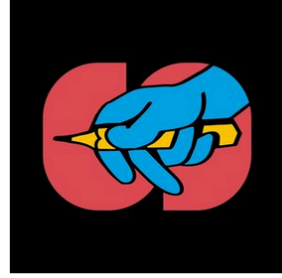


Counter Culture Labs is a citizen science and DIYbio space that is open sourcing biology

Liberated Lens is a radical film & video collective dedicated to social change



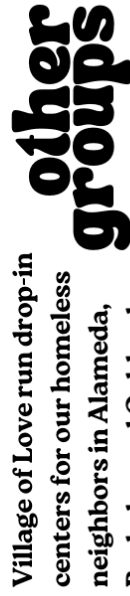
Sketchboard is a figure drawing collective, that serves as a creative act of resistance against cultural homogenization.

DISCO ROOM

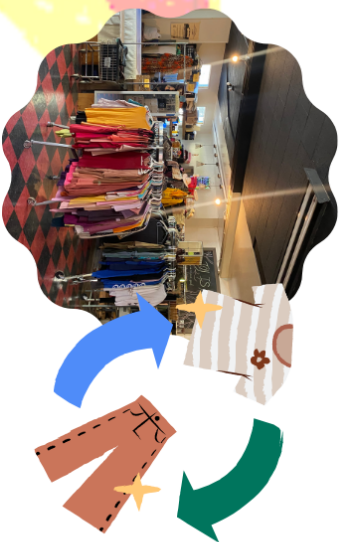
Can host 49 people. Great for physical movement, including dance, self defense classes, body therapy, film shooting, workshops & more!
