INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRINTING:


- This zine is designed to fit on a standard letter-sized sheet of paper (8½ x 11-in)
- 2. In print settings:
 - A. Select the range 1-1 (you don't need to print this instruction page)
 - B. Set the scale of the image to print at 100%
 - C. If possible, print with black and white printer presets
- Depending on the printer, you may need to experiment a couple of times with the settings to get it right
- Remember that the goal is not perfection, it's participation -- it's okay if some of the edges get cut off ♥

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ASSEMBLY:

- 1. You will need a pair of scissors
- 2. Ultimately, you will fold a standard letter-sized sheet of paper into eighths
- 3. There are printed guidelines provided to help you
